**I** Ami と Fuko の対話を読み、後の問いに答えなさい。

Ami : This \*sticker is very \*cool! Is this a \*national flag?

Fuko : Yes, it's the flag of Australia.

Ami : Wow! Did you go to Australia?

Fuko : Yes, I did. I went to Australia for our school trip.

Ami : This is the first time I've ever seen the Australian flag. It's very interesting!

Fuko : The Australian flag is made up of three parts. First, \*the Union Jack is in the top left corner. Second, \*the Commonwealth Star is in the \*bottom left corner. Third, \*the Southern Cross takes up the right half of the flag.

Ami : What's the Union Jack? I've never heard it before.

Fuko : It's the flag of \*the United Kingdom.

Ami : Why is the flag of the United Kingdom in the Australian flag?

Fuko : Because Australia was once a \*British colony.

Ami : I see. The flag of New Zealand, like Australia, also has the Union Jack in the same place as the Australian flag. ①New Zealand was also a British colony. ( ) ( )?

Fuko : Yes, exactly.

Ami : I want to know the meanings of the Commonwealth Star and the Southern Cross in the Australian flag. What do they mean?

Fuko : The Commonwealth Star, the biggest one, is a \*seven-pointed star. The seven points \*represent the \*unity of the six \*states and the \*territories of the Commonwealth of Australia.

Ami : \*That makes sense! What about the Southern Cross? I have heard the name of this \*constellation. We can see it only in Okinawa in Japan.

Fuko : Yes, but it is also \*visible in Australia, just like in Okinawa. The Southern Cross represents Australia's position in \*the southern hemisphere.

Ami : ②That's a good way to represent Australia. Every part of the Australian flag has its own meaning.

Fuko : Yes, learning the parts of a national flag leads to learning about the nation's history, \*geography, and many other interesting facts!

Ami : ③What is the difference between the Australian flag and the New Zealand one?

Fuko : The stars are different. On the Australian flag, there are five seven-pointed stars and one \*five-pointed star. On the New Zealand flag, there are four five-pointed stars.

Ami : So, the stars on the New Zealand flag have a different meaning, right?

Fuko : Well, the number of points doesn't mean anything, but the four stars represent the Southern Cross, just like the Australian flag.

Ami : Oh, I see.

Since Sara spent so much time outside in the cold, she became very sick when she finished the body of the snowman. She was in bed for several days. Her grandmother read to her, her father often brought a cup of hot milk, and her mother sang to her. \*Thanks to their \*attention and kindness, she got well and was able to finish building her snowman.

When her snowman was finally finished, she showed it to her family and they were surprised by how big it was. He even had a face and clothes. "While I was making this snowman, ② I made a wish," Sara said. Her grandmother asked, "What did you wish for?" Sara answered, "It's a secret!"

Ten years later, she came to understand the meaning behind the snowman \*tradition. Not only her \*effort ③ also the support of her family \*fulfilled her wish: to be a nurse! Sara is very \*grateful and never forgets to thank her snowman and her family for helping make her dream come true.

Today still, the people in Sara's town continue to build many snowmen, hoping that their wishes and dreams come true. Whenever Sara sees these snowmen, she thinks of the wish of the person who built them and she hopes that their dreams will come true, just like hers.
